MAN: Side left, -, cross right in back of left, recover left;

WOMAN: Side right, -, cross left in back of right, recover right;

NOTE: May be done in Closed or Butterfly Position.

Traveling Chasse

Traveling Chasse

SQQ;

FWD TRN, -, SD, CL;

(BK TRN, -, SD, CL;)

MAN: Forward left turning left face diagonally across Line of Progression with right shoulder lead with both hands joined low between partners, -, side right diagonal Line of Progression, close left;

WOMAN: Back right turning left face diagonally across Line of Progression with left shoulder lead with both hands joined low between partners, -, side left diagonal Line of Progression, close right;

NOTE: Traveling Chasse is a progressive figure. Traveling Chasse may also start with the man's right and woman's left foot. In that case, the man would commence turning right face with a left shoulder lead and the woman would turn right with a right shoulder lead. When facing Line of Progression, the total amount of turn is 1/8. When facing Diagonal Line of Progression, the total amount of turn is 1/4. Partners should remain facing throughout this figure with shoulders parallel.

MAN: Side left with slight right face turn, -, cross right in back of left, recover left;

WOMAN: Side right with slight right face turn, -, cross left in front of right, recover right;

NOTE: May start with man's right and woman's left with slight left face turn.

Underarm Turn

SD, -, XIB, REC;

(SD TRN, -, FWD TRN, REC TRN;)

MAN: Side left to join lead hands palm-to-palm, -, cross right in back of left, recover left;

WOMAN: Side right commence to turn right face under joined lead hands, -, cross left over right to Line of Progression continue turn right face 1/2, recover forward on right complete turn to face partner;
