1---8 (CP-LOD) WALK,-,2,-; SIDE CLOSE,(R) TURN 1/2,-; (CP-RLOD) BACKUP,-,2,-; SIDE CLOSE,(R) TURN,-;
(CP-WALL) SIDE,-,(Opp) CROSS (M XIB & W XIF),-; (L) TURN TWO-STEP;

(CP-COH) SIDE,-,(Opp) CROSS (M XIB & W XIF),-; (R) TURN TWO-STEP;

1.....(CP-M facing LOD) Walk fwd 2 slow steps L,-,R,-;

2.....Do 1 R-turn two-step turning half to end CP M facing RLOD;

4.....Do 1 R-turn two-step turning 3/4 to end CP M facing wall;

5.....Side L, XLIB of L (W XLIF),- (like a half twisty vine);

6.....Do 1 L-turn two-step side L, close R, turn L 1/2 on L to end CP M facing COH , -;

7.....Side R twd LOD, -, XLIB of R (W XRIF),-;

8.....Do 1 R-turn two-step side R, close L, turn R 1/2 on R to end CP-Wall momentarily, -;

9---16 (SCP-LOD) WALK,-,2,-; (M) HITCH (W Sciss) TO BJO,2,3,-; BACKUP,-,2,-;

(Both) SCISS TO SCAR RLOD,2,3,-; (W TWIRL) M BK, -,BK TURN L 1/4,-(CP-WALL);

SIDE CLOSE SIDE,-; THRU (Manuv),-,SIDE CLOSE; (CP-RLOD) PIVOT,-,2,-(CP-LOD);

9.....(SCP-LOD) Walk 2 slow steps L,-,R,-;

10.....M hitch fwd L, close R, bk L,-(as W scissors thru side R, close L, thru R to Bjo,-);

11.....(BJO-LOD) M backup 2 slow steps R,-,L,-;

12.....(BOTH) Do a scissors to SCAR M facing RLOD (M XIB & W XIF);

13.....As W twirls RF in 2 slow cts M steps bk L, -, bk turn L 1/4 on R to end CP-Wall, -;

14.....(CP-M face wall) Side L, close R, side L,-;

15.....Step thru on R (W on L) maneuvering to CP-RLOD, -, side L, close R;

16.....(CP-M face RLOD) Do 1 slow couple pivot in 2 cts L,-,R,- end CP-LOD;

7-8.... CP M facing RLOD do 2 RF couple pivots in 4 slow cts L,-,R,-; L,-,R,-(CP-LOD);

9---16 (CP-LOD) FWD,-,(Bio) CHECK,-; FISHTAIL-4; (Fwd) HITCH-4; FWD,-,TURN 1/4 (CP-WALL),-;

After recovering on last meas of Part B last time thru, there will be one final "ping" note of music. Just PUSH APART on that "ping". Optional: (As couple "pushes apart" they take a R-handshake as though saying "Goodnight"!)

- 3-4 Bk LOD 2 slow steps R, -, L, -; Do one RF trning two-step trn $\frac{3}{4}$ to CP wall R, L, R, -;

5 – 8 [CP WALL] SD, -, CROSS [MXIB1(WXIF), -, TRN LF TWO-STEP; [CP COH] SD, -, CROSS [MXIB1(WXIF), -, TRN RF TWO-STEP [CP WALL];

After recovering on last Meas of Part B, last time thru dance there will be a one final “ping” of music. Just PUSH APART on that “ping”.

NOTE: Optional – As cpl “PUSHES APART” they take R-Handshake as though saying “Goodnight”. Or kiss as you DIP BK, either is acceptable for the ending.
